
WORLD Hearing Day 2024 Report



In the Ear and Screening Camp, total numbers of 120 people were screened. Out of 120 numbers, 91 Male and 29 were participated in this camp.




ENT & Community Medicine Department of Maulana Azad Medical College (MAMC), New Delhi, technical support from Sound Hearing 2030 and ALPS International in collaboration with NIHFW clinic organized an Ear & Hearing Screening Camp on the occasion of 47th Annual Day of NIHFW. In this Ear & Hearing Screening camp120 people were screened out of which 46 were identified in the red flag category and were prescribed appropriate tests & medicines along with the distribution of medicines. 19 of the screened people required Audiometry testing, out of which two were diagnosed with mild hearing loss, two with moderate hearing loss & one with severe hearing loss. Those who needed further management were referred to ENT Department of MAMC. New Delhi.
