World Hearing Day Hearing Screening Camp in Jungpura School




An Ear and Hearing Care Screening Camp was organized in Nav Abhiyan school and slum area community of Bhogal (Jungpura). The team of Dr. Ravi Meher, Director Professor & Head of ENT and Dr. M. Meghachandra Singh, Director Prof.& Head, Community Medicine with Sound Hearing 2030 team AGSG Health foundation actively took part in this Ear and Hearing Care Screening Camp. In the screening camp patients were screened with Ear and Hearing problem along with their co-morbidities. They were also given medicine and the patients who needed further treatment were referred to the OPD of Lok Nayak Hospital.


A total number of 71 persons were screened where in 46 were female and 25 were male.

Out of 71, 37 were diagnosed with different diseases, were treated and referred for further treatment.

Out of these 37 people, 23 were female and 14 were male.



The different age group participants were screened. Out of 71 participants screened, 40 were in and age 10 years, 5 were of age 11-20 and 2 were of 21-30 age group, 9 participants were of age group 31-40 and 10 belonged to the age of 41-50. 2 were of 51-60 age group and 3 were more than 60 years of age.



Out of 71 participants screened, 23 were suffering from impacted wax, 6 from Ear Itching, 1 low hearing, 1 was suffering from foot injury, 2 were suffering from ear retraction, 3 came with complaint of aural fullness and 1 came with ear discharge,
